As one of the few women to cover the Majors, Fruth brings a fresh perspective the field.

After capturing the attention of Major League Baseball with her front page-worthy shots, Fruth spent a decade covering the San Francisco Giants and Oakland Athletics. Named a Sony Artisan of Imagery, she built a storied career documenting the sport from youth games to professional pennant races around the world. Drawing on her extensive interviews with baseball legends, the all-women league that inspired the film "A League of Their Own," and the trailblazers of today, Fruth paints a vivid picture of the sport's rich history and exciting future.
